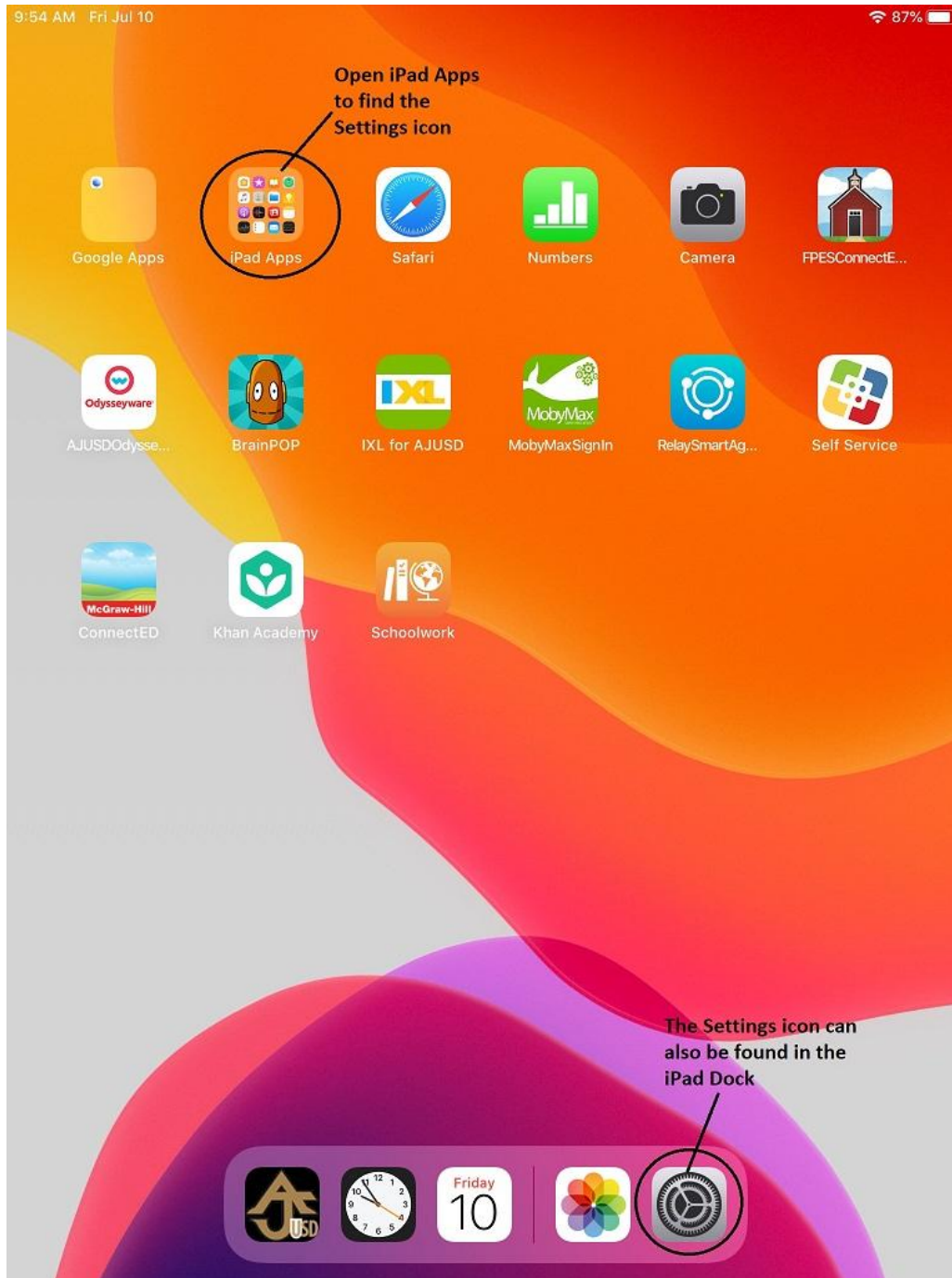
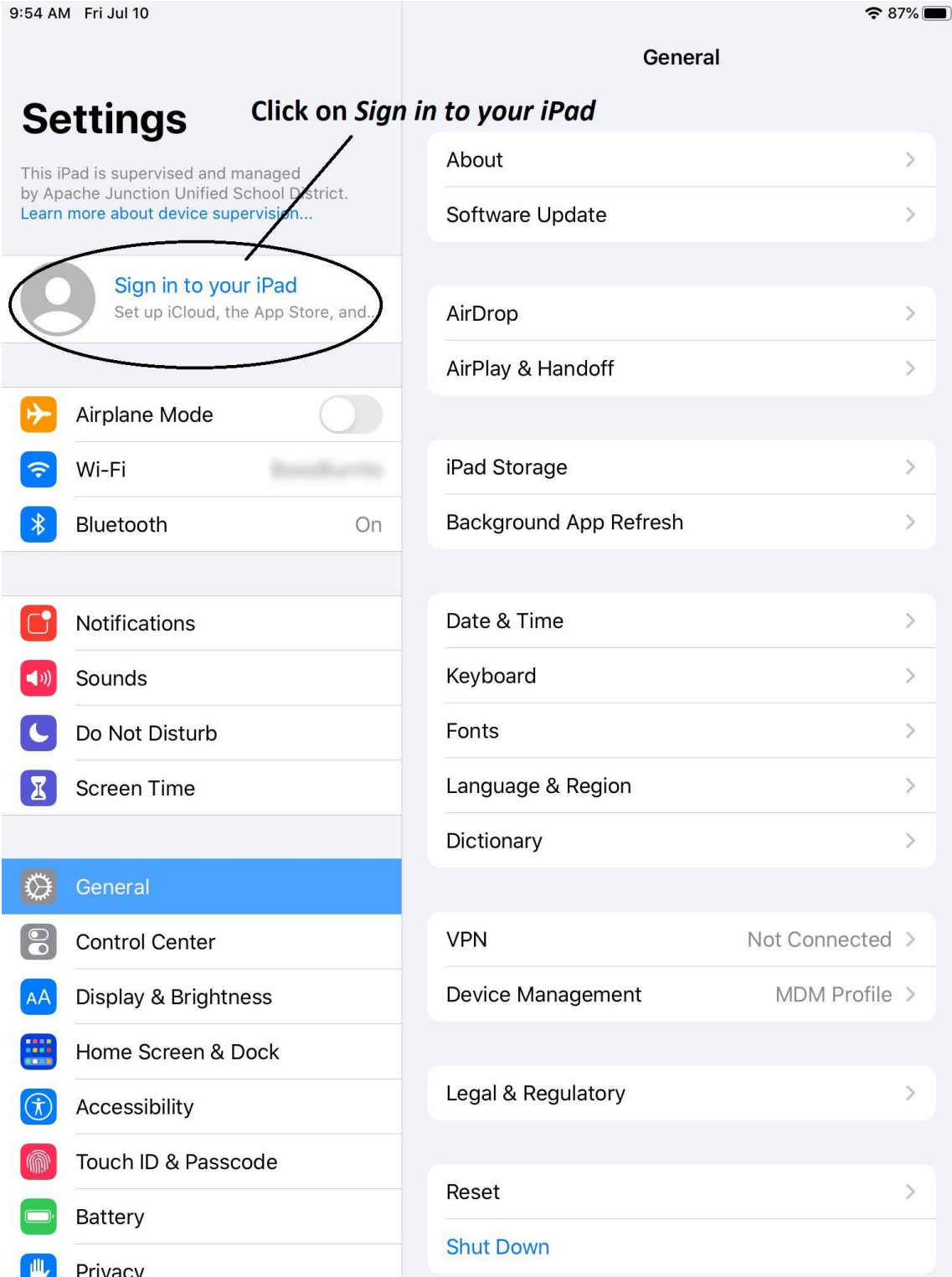


Log into your iPad

1. Click on the Settings icon (can be found in the *iPad Apps* folder or the *iPad Dock* at the bottom of the screen):

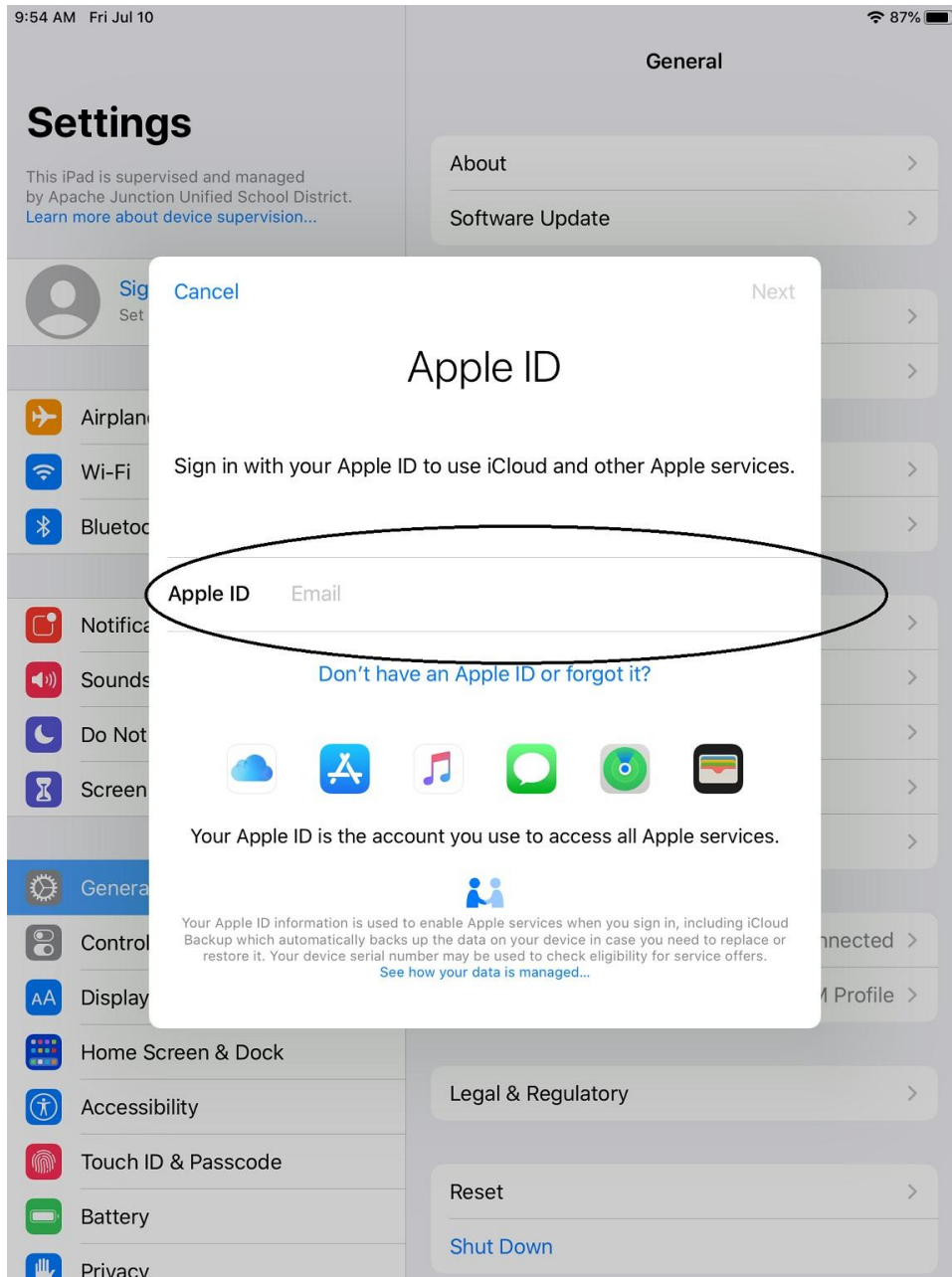


2. Click on the *Sign in to your iPad* to begin the login process:



3. Click on the *Apple ID* box. You will enter the student's GOAJ email address here (you can obtain this info from either your student's teacher or the front office of your student's school).
 - a. The format of the email address will be something like *15mbolan@goaj.org*.

- b. If any other email address is entered, the student will not appear in their teacher's roster and will not be able to participate in classroom activities.



4. Below is an example of a correct GOAJ login:

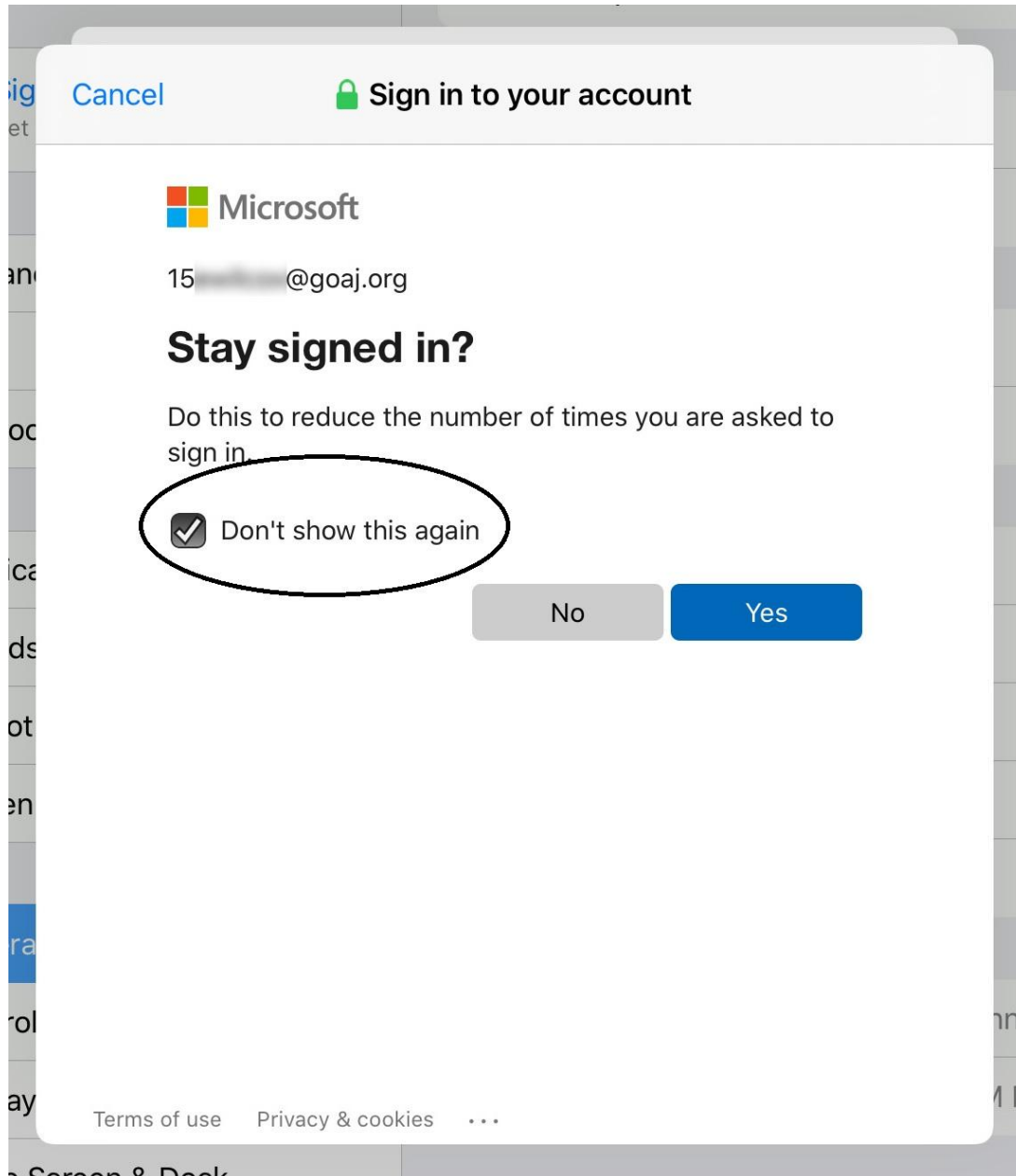

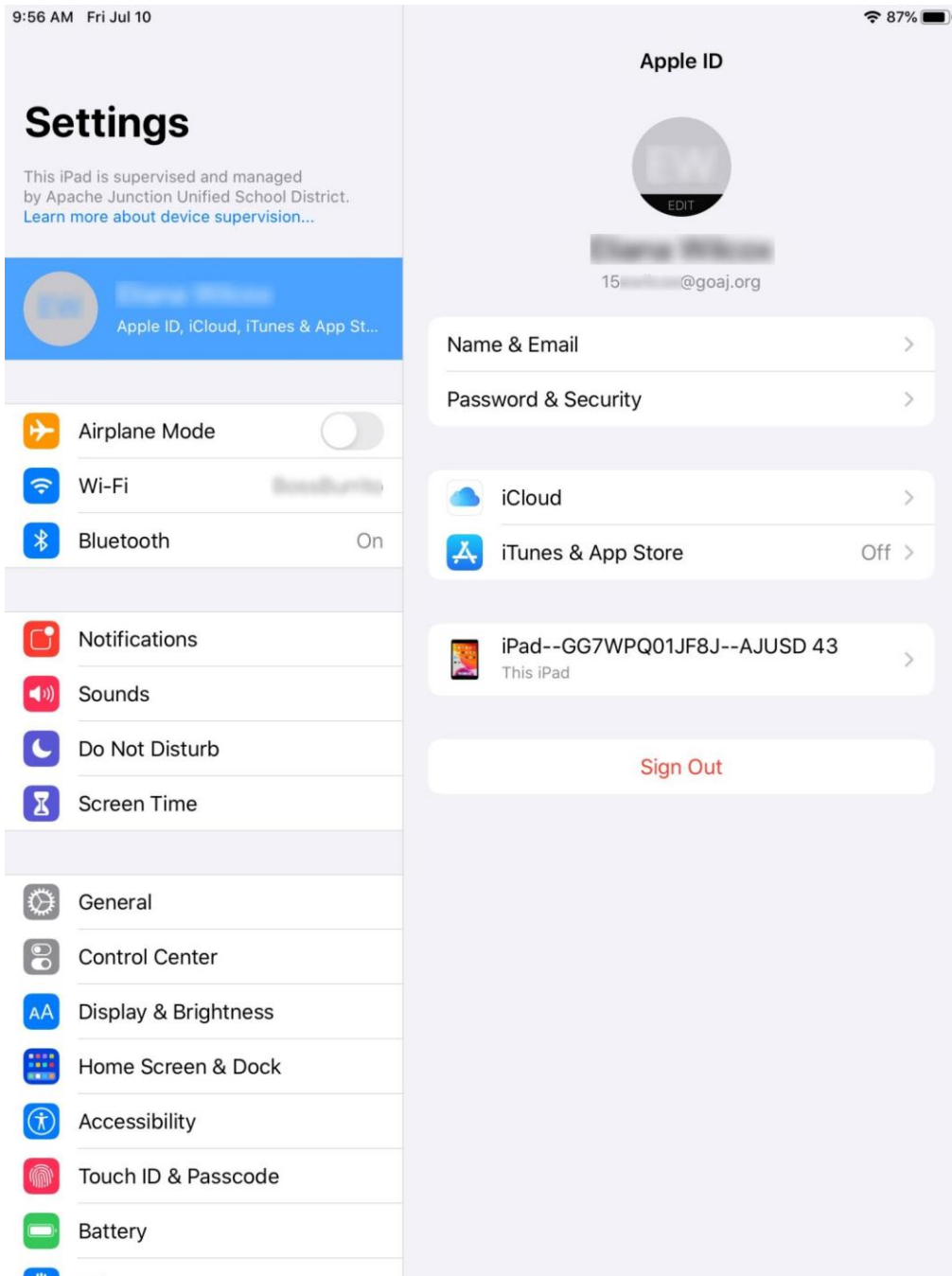

7. Click on the *Don't show this again* check-box, then click Yes. This will store the login information for the student on the iPad and will keep them logged in. **However**, you may be prompted to enter your password again some time in the future. This may happen after an iPad update or if the device loses battery power.



8. You're done! If all goes well, your screen should look something like the one below (without all of the blurred-out areas, of course):



If you have any issues logging in, check the email address; that is the most common problem. Also make sure that you have an Internet connection (see *Connect your iPad to a network*). If for any reason you cannot get logged into your iPad, please contact either your teacher or your school office.
