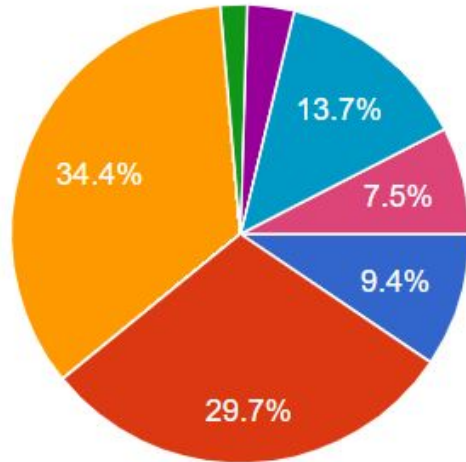

As of March 22, 2021

- The entire AJUSD system will move back to an **In Person Learning Model**; families still have the option to remain in the online learning model.
 - All employees will be back to work at their site.
 - Masks are mandatory for all staff and students.

In Person Traditional Learning Model

- **Will begin on March 22**
 - **Parents have made a choice** for the In Person or Online Learning Model
 - Teachers will continue to collaborate to support each other and share ideas of what is happening in the classroom.
 - Students will be supported regardless of the model that has been chosen for them by their parents.

In Person Traditional Learning Model

Elementary

- All in person students will remain with their current teachers
 - Learning models will run synchronous
 - Online learners will participate with the In Person learners
 - Teacher will work in whole groups, small groups, and individually based on students' needs
 - Students will continue to receive their Special Education services as written in their IEP
 - Students will receive PE, Music, Library, Art (FPES) weekly

In Person Traditional Learning Model

Elementary continued

- Students will have
 - Lunch with their peers
 - Recess
 - Both the lunch and recess plans vary at each site
 - Staff will continue to clean their areas throughout the day with the custodial staff completing more focused / deep cleaning.
 - Staff will support an environment which everyone is wearing masks, social distancing is occurring, and sanitizing hands/areas continue.

In Person Learning

Elementary School

School Day: Normal School Hours for each site

- Students will move about the campus like normal but must follow any directional signs when commuting.
- Masks are worn properly all day, on campus, and on the bus.
- Desks will be spread apart as much as possible.
- Proper hand washing and sanitizing will be encouraged.
- Drinking fountains will be unavailable so students must bring a water bottle.
- Health screenings will be completed daily at school and should be done at home every morning prior to students attending school.

In Person Learning

Elementary School

Lunch:

- During Lunch students may remove the mask when consuming food and drink.
 - Groups of students may not exceed 5 students
 - Seating will be spread out between inside and outside locations.

In Person Learning

Elementary School

Recess:

- Students will have breaks throughout the day to be outside and take their masks off
 - During their lunch recess students can take off their masks when they are not directly together
 - Cohorting during recess will be followed to keep groups together.

In Person Learning

Secondary School

School Day: 7:15am-2pm

- Students rotate through classes and will move about the campus like normal but must follow any directional signs when commuting.
- Masks are worn properly all day, on campus, and on the bus.
- Desks will be spread apart as much as possible.
- Proper hand washing and sanitizing will be encouraged.
- Drinking fountains will be unavailable so students must bring a water bottle.
- Health screenings will be completed daily at school and should be done at home every morning prior to students attending school.

Current Steps:

- Online Learning Model will continue through March 5
- Parents are completing the waiver as students return to campus (students without a waiver can not be on campus as of March 22)
- Wednesday/Friday evenings used for deep cleaning with the weekend to have 48 hours with no one in the classroom/school site before each Monday
- Teachers/Administration are preparing their learning environments for the first day back to **In Person Learning on Monday, March 22**

COVID-19 Assumption of Risk Form

Parent Responsibility / Understanding of the forms

- COVID-19 Waiver, Release, and Assumption of Risk Form
 - Parent Understanding of the Form
 - **For students returning to school in the In Person Traditional Learning Model on March 22**
 - **Parents are REQUIRED to complete the waiver form in order for students to return to any AJUSD campus**
 - COVID-19 Waiver form must be completed for **in person and online students** to participate in athletics, clubs, and on-campus school events

Current Steps Continued:

- Educate the staff, students, and parents to get used to the new “normal”
 - Recognizing symptoms
 - Wearing Masks (no religious exemptions per our legal counsel)
 - Social Distancing
 - Handwashing
 - The staff continues to discuss that things are “safe”
 - Current resignations/Modified Work/FMLA requests
 - Transportation, Food Services, Custodial are getting used to the new “normal”
 - Procedures on the bus
 - Food Prep, distribution of breakfast/lunch
 - Daily Cleaning vs Deep Cleaning

Daily Health Screener for all students

- Parents will review the signs / scan children daily for any major symptoms
 - **Temperature 100 or higher**
 - **Shortness of breath**
 - **Cough**
 - **Runny nose, sneezing**
 - **Muscle Pain**
 - **Tiredness**
 - Has the child or anyone in the family been exposed to anyone with COVID-19 symptoms?
 - Is the information that you are collecting true and accurate?
 - Students sent home with symptoms may return in 72 hours if symptom free
-

Current Steps Continued:

- Transportation
 - All students will wear face coverings
 - Students will not be socially distanced 6 feet apart on the bus so the practice of these protocols will be important on the bus
 - All students will be routed to return to school March 22
- Food Services
 - Preparing for students to have breakfast/lunch on campus
- Custodial Services
 - Working together with site administration to prepare the campus as well as planning for cleaning/deep cleaning that will be done when staff/students return to campus

Current Steps Continued:

- Athletics
 - Practice/Tryouts will begin on March 1 **AJHS**
 - Girls' Tennis Softball, Baseball, Track
 - Spring Football
 - Practice/Tryouts will begin April 1 **CCJH**
 - Boys' Basketball, Wrestling, Girl's Soccer
 - Coaching Staff and Athletes will follow AIA recommendations
 - COVID release
 - Health Screener
 - Masks
