Distance Learning Model - Secondary

To start the school year, Apache Junction Unified School District will provide online classroom instruction for all students until they are allowed back in their schools. Our teachers are highly qualified to provide a rigorous online educational experience for the student learner. Though we prefer to have students at their school and in their classrooms, the health and safety of our students and staff is our number one priority.

- The school day would run from 9am-2pm for all students in grades 7th-12th grade.
- Students would follow their class schedule daily; meeting with each period teacher for a specific amount of time.
- Teachers would instruct students in their core class each day.
- Students will have their elective classes each day.
- Students would have lunch for 30 minutes during the school day.
- Students would have time to engage socially with their classmates.

Secondary Curriculum

- Edgenuity will be used as the online platform.
- Teachers will enhance their lessons with their current curriculum and online resources.

Technology Supports

- All students in grades 7 through 12th grade will be given a chromebook
- Hotspots are available for families who do not currently have internet service.
- There is a help desk that is support for families and staff. Contact Tech Support at 480-246-6500, Monday - Friday, 8 a.m. - 3 p.m. After-hours please leave a message. (Topics include login difficulties and other student technology questions.
- Teachers will have the option of teaching from their classrooms to allow for the use of their school tools as well as the space they have to include internet access.

Expectations for Students

- Attendance will be taken daily for all students.
- Grades will be given based on the work that students complete and the effort that they put into their work.
- Students who do not attend class will be marked absent; absences will impact a student's overall grade point average.
- Students who do not complete the assigned work will not be given passing grades

- Any student who does not attend school for 10 consecutive days will be dropped from enrollment.
- Students who have excess absences will be reported to the truancy officer, following discipline from their site administration.
