Purchase Justification

This contract is intended to assist the District in implementing innovative solutions to increase student achievement. Vendors were requested to give pricing for pilot programs and implementation pricing. The intent is to provide districts with pre-qualified vendors in which they can select the product that best fits their curriculum. The only products awarded are the specific products the vendors submitted in their response. Mesa Public Schools Curriculum Department will continue to work through the formal acceptance process we currently have in place in determining the functionality and usage on an as-needed basis. The Strategic Alliance for Volume Expenditures (SAVE) members throughout the state may also utilize the contract and will individually determine their use of the contract by either pilot programs or evaluation of any combination of products.

Executive Summary:


This proposal was released on February 13, 2013 to vendors, with a closing date of March 19, 2013 @ 2:00 P.M. There were eighty-six responses with seventy-nine being recommended for award. This is a five-year contract, with the first year expenditures estimated at \$140,000.00

Recommendation is to award this bid to multiple vendors that will best serve the needs of this District and the SAVE members.
