**IN ORDER to be interviewed, YOU MUST HAVE ALL
PAPERWORK LISTED BELOW,
IT MUST BE CURRENT AND
All PAPERWORK MUST BE UNDER YOUR NAME**

1. Proof of Residence. You must bring the following:
 - a. Mortgage Company paperwork (if buying your house)
 - b. Lease agreement (if renting), must be up to date and with all occupants living within the household listed.
2. You must bring documentation of your most recent bills.
 - a. Water, electric, garbage, gas, sewer, phone, cell phone, if you own your house, your tax bill, auto payments, auto insurance, homeowner's insurance **in other words anything you pay.** You must have documentation of all your bills.
3. Proof of Income of **entire** household. You must bring the following: Current pay check stubs (**for one current month**), or if starting a new job- a letter from your employer on Company Letter Head stating when you started working, Hourly wage, Hours per week.
 - a. Bank Statement recent month showing deposits.
 - b. If you get food stamps – Awards Letter
 - c. SSI – Awards Letter
 - d. Child Support – Awards Letter
 - e. And any other income you must bring documentation.
 - f. If being paid in cash you must bring a bank statement.**YOU MUST HAVE AN adequate INCOME to be considered for any emergency financial assistance.**
4. **All school age children living within the household must be attending an Apache Junction Unified School District school regularly minimum of TWO weeks. And you and your family must live in the Apache Junction Unified School District boundaries.**
5. Community Service is required in exchange for assistance, **with the exception of Back to School & Christmas program.**
