IF WE HAVE FUNDS.

All school age children living within the household must be attending one of our AJUSD schools regularly and live within the AJUSD Boundaries.

The family must have an **emergency**
(Something out of the ordinary)

That has happened within **their** Immediate household to cause them to need financial assistance.

The family must have an income to be able to pay their Major monthly bills normally. Such as (Rent, Mortgage, Utilities, food or Food stamps).

We do not assist with Phone bills or Credit cards.

We do not Find or provide Housing/Shelter or

Transportation. If the household has received financial help from us within the last **12 months** and are asking for financial help with the same bill we cannot help. If they owe volunteer hours to us for **Financial** assistance or more than 4 hours for shopping in our shop we cannot help.

Everyone is required to do community service to repay services we provide.

The Parent / Legal Guarding must come in and reapply every new school year as everyone does and provide all written documentation.

We can not assist single people or elderly people. We are a private AJUSD program. We are funded 100% by community donations. We are not a Government, State, County, City program we do not receive funding from them.

**The only acceptance is with A J -Head Start programs, who we have a written agreement with.
